From 1 July 2024, Hungary will hold the Presidency of the Council of the European Union for six months. In the framework of the interparliamentary cooperation of the Presidency the 25th Interparliamentary Conference for the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) and the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) will be held in Budapest on 9-10 September 2024, organised by the Hungarian National Assembly.
